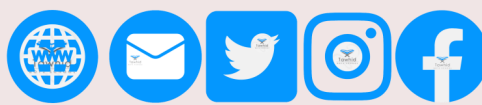

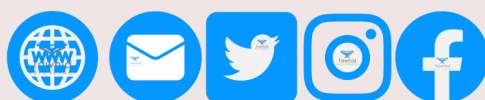
CAREERS UPDATES

Hadith of the week

The blessed month of Rajab



Rajab is the seventh month in the Islamic lunar calendar. This month was regarded as one of the sacred months (*Al-Ashhur-al-hurum*) in which battles were prohibited in the days of the Holy Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam). It is also deemed to be a prelude to the month of Ramadan, because the month of Ramadan follows it after the intervening month of Sha'ban. Therefore, when the Holy Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) sighted the moon of Rajab, he used to pray to Allah in the following words:

O Allah, make the months of Rajab and Sha'ban blessed for us, and let us reach the month of Ramadan (i.e. prolong our life up to Ramadan, so that we may benefit from its merits and blessings).



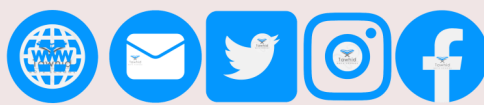
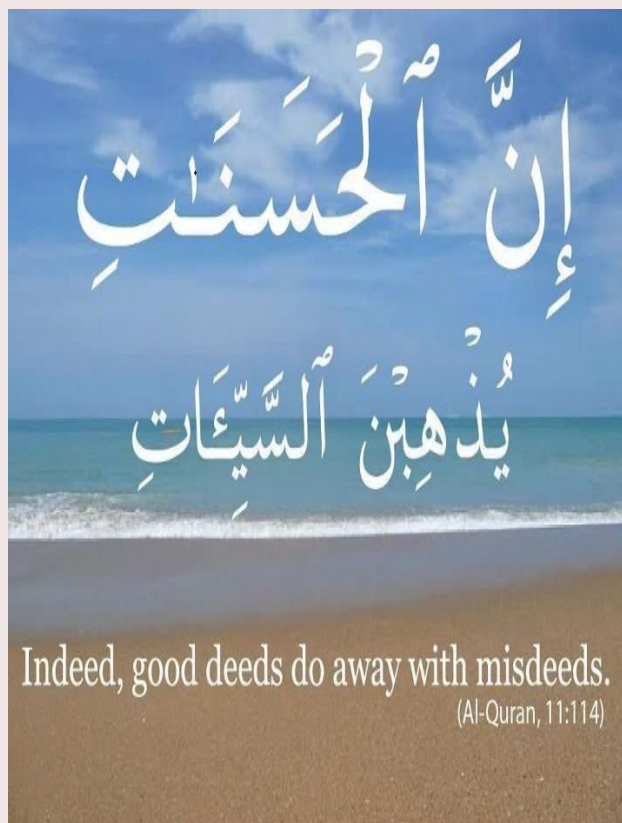
The Prophet (PBUH) encouraging to do good

Good deeds remove misdeeds

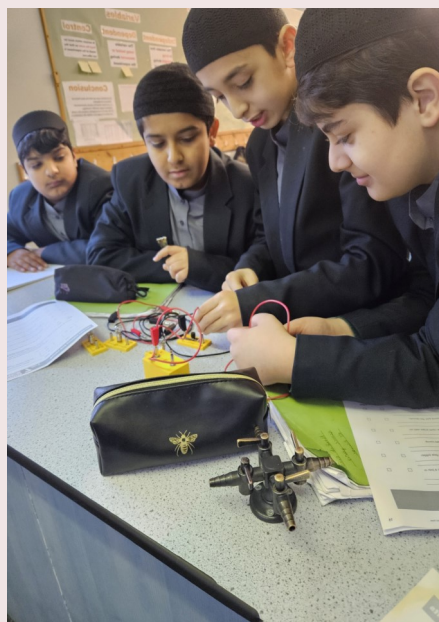
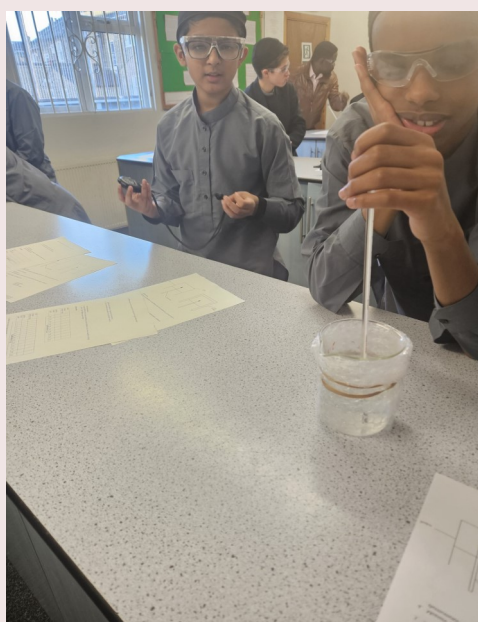

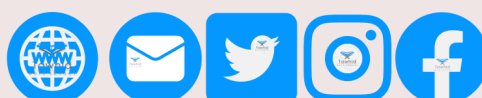
