
The Great Reward of Wudu

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7	In History, Year 7s are currently learning about Water and Health through time (Unit 1). They are learning how the water and health has evolved and how each period improved the uses of them. For example, Cholera was discovered in the 1800's and was created by sewage water mixing with clean water.
8	Year 8 are currently studying Unit 4, Understanding the Changing World, 1450 -1750. This period covers a series of events which transpired and shaped the world to what it is today. For example, year 8s have learnt about Leonardo da Vinci who was an Artist, Engineer, Scientist and how his actions changed and reformed the world.
9	Year 9 have started GCSE History. The first of four books, Crime and Punishment, is about the evolution of crime and punishment in England. Year 9s are currently studying period c1000-c1500. This period consists of when England was conquered by the Normans and what laws were set.
10	Year 10 have started their second GCSE History book, King Richard and King John. Year 10 have completed Unit 1, which is about Life and Government in England (1189-1216). Year 10's is making good progress and are learning how life was like in the medieval period.
11	Year 11's has started a new GCSE book called Superpower and Relations: The Cold War. This is a book which was just introduced this academic year. The first Unit of this book is about the aftermath of the Nazi, Germany war and the relations between USA, UK and the Soviet Union.



Careers Update





On the 6th October we were visited by three students, two were former students at our school. They discuss where they are currently within education, challenges they faced with transition into colleges & HE education, the importance of managing studies and how to make the right choices when choosing courses and applying for colleges. The visit ended with a Q & A session which the Year 11s found very helpful and beneficial.

Some information about the Alumni students:

Mohamed Farah: His journey of academia started off at Aylward Academy. Alhamdulillah, for his GCSEs he received one grade 9, four grade 8s and three grade 7s. After receiving his GCSEs, he enrolled at LAET and decided he wanted to do A Levels. So at LAET he studied Mathematics, Computer Science and Physics. At the end of his sixth form journey he received two A*s and one B. Currently, he will be starting an internship at Fujitsu as a Data Analyst. InshaAllah, his plan is to reapply for a top university for Computer Science and try his best to become a software developer.



Prince Nasim Ermis studied at Tawhid from 2016-2021. Alhamdulillah he managed to achieve six grade 9s, three grade 8s and two grade 7s in his GCSEs. In his A-levels he decided to take Biology, Chemistry and Mathematics at the London Academy of Excellence Tottenham (LAET), and Alhamdulillah achieved A*s in all 3 of his A-levels. He plans to study medicine in the future at a top university Insha'Allah.

Abu Bakr Snell: GCSE Results achieved: five Grade 9s, four Grade 8s, one Grade 7 and one Grade 6.
