#### Actions to Attain the Reward of Hajj

Even though we cannot visit His Sacred House and be physically present in the inimitable atmosphere of DArafah and Dajj, we can still hope to obtain similar rewards inshā'Allah by performing the following actions:

#### 1. Fajr in congregation, dhikr until sunrise followed by two rakahs

The Messenger of Allah ﷺsaid: "Whoever offers Fajr in congregation and remains seated, engaging in the remembrance of Allah until the sun has risen, and then offers two rakDahs, he will have a reward equal to that of performing Dajj and Dumrah." He ﷺsaid: "Complete, complete, complete (i.e. complete reward)" (Tirmidhī).

The scholars have also stated that this reward is equally applicable to a woman (praying at home) who sits in the place where she performs Fajr and remembers Allah or recites the Qur'ān until sunrise.

#### 2. Salah in congregation

The Messenger of Allah ﷺsaid: "Whoever leaves his house having purified himself for the compulsory prayer, his reward is like the reward of the pilgrim in i□rām..." (Abū Dāwūd).

#### 3. Going to the Masjid to learn or teach

The Messenger of Allah ﷺsaid: "Whoever goes to the Masjid, only intending to learn some good or teach it, he will have the reward of a complete Dajj." (Dabarānī)

In the past, people would travel far and wide to seek knowledge. Now, even though we have scholars and classes on our doorsteps, we struggle to devote time to attending lectures and classes in the Masjid. Let us change this by seeking knowledge in the Houses of Allah.

Ibn Maajah (242) narrated that Abu Hurayrah said:
"The good deeds that will reach a believer after his death are:

1) knowledge which he learned and then spread;
2) a righteous son whom he leaves behind;
3) a copy of the Qu'aan that he leaves as a legacy;
4) a mosque that he built;
5) a house that he built for wayfarers;
6) a canal that he dug; or

7) charity that he gave during his lifetime when he was in good health.

## Hadith on knowledge being lifted

"Verily, Allah does not take away knowledge by snatching it from the people, but He takes it away by taking away (the lives of) the religious scholars till none of the scholars stays alive. Then the people will take ignorant ones as their leaders, who, when asked to deliver religious verdicts, will issue them without knowledge, the result being that they will go astray and will lead others astray". (Bukhari and Muslim)

The lessons we learn from this hadith is that it is a sign of the nearness of the Day of Judgement that the world will be deprived of genuine religious scholars, and illiterate people will become leaders who will have neither the knowledge of the Quran nor that of the Hadith. Despite their ignorance of the Quran and the Hadith, they will be called Mujtahid (jurist entitled to independent reasoning) and Imam (leader) and will mislead people with their legal opinions and self-created problems. Besides urging us to acquire religious knowledge with a view to producing more scholars in the society, this Hadith also warns us against the ignorant self-styled `Ulama'
